To graduate and be eligible to take the State Board exam for a license you must do the following:

1. Cosmetology Operator Students - Complete 1500 hours of training
2. Pass written and practical exams,
3. Complete all credits in clinical experiences
4. Make satisfactory academic progress
5. Satisfy all financial obligations to the school.

COSMETOLOGY INSTRUCTOR STUDENTS

To graduate and be eligible to take the State Board exam for a license you must do the following:

1. Cosmetology Instructor Student - 750 hours of training
2. Pass written exams
3. Complete all theory and clinic operations
4. Complete teaching and clinical management
5. Make satisfactory academic progress
6. Satisfy all financial obligations to the school.
